#### CON'T

### THE FIVE COMMITMENTS OF TRUE LOVE WAITS:

- **To God:** *Matt.22:37* - "Jesus replied, 'Love the Lord your God with all your heart and with all your soul and with all your mind.'"
- **To Yourself:** *Matt.22:39* - "And the second is like it: 'Love your neighbor as yourself.'"
- **To Family:** *Phil.4:5* - "Let your gentleness be evident to all. The Lord is near."
- **To Friends:** *Jh.15:13* - "Greater love has no one than this, that he lay down his life for his friends."
- **To Future Mate and Children:** *2Tim.2:22* - "Flee the evil desires of youth, and pursue righteousness, faith, love and peace, along with those who call on the Lord out of a pure heart."

**THE PLEDGE:** "Believing that true love waits, I make a commitment to God, myself, my family, my friends, my future mate and my future children to be sexually abstinent from this day

until the day I enter a biblical marriage relationship."

More than a million young people world wide have signed covenant cards containing this pledge. "The decision to remain sexually abstinent until marriage is the right choice. The commitment to abstinence from now until you're married demonstrates great strength, great conviction, and great wisdom. You cannot do this unless you have a true conviction of faith in the Lord Jesus Christ, that He will have the power to keep you all the way.

Just listening to your conscience is not enough, but being led by the Spirit of the Living God causes you to walk with integrity in his righteousness. The power of the flesh will over-ride the conscience thinking, when you're not prayed up, fasted up, or having

that quiet time when He gives that discernment as to how to handle things that will try to get out of hand. Do you want God's full power or your pretend power. A lot of churches and/or preachers do not address the sexuality of the singles. For the single Christian, their love should be so engrossed with the Lord not in the hormones. Allow God to take center stage. Allow Him to develop you for your mate. Allow him to mature you.

Most times we come into marriage really undeveloped. You should not want love at any cost. **True Love only comes from Christ**—that Unconditional Love. We don't have to coerce God to love us, but He just loves us because of Who He Is!

The enemy talks to that flesh but God Speaks to the

spirit man in you and lifts you and encourages you to believe you are better than what you're settling for. Don't allow sex to manipulate you. This has to be a constant reminder in your life when confronting with the opposite sex. **Will you be true or will you compromise your values.** Not a lot of singles know about True Love Waits. However, I'm hoping the parents have taught them well and even after teaching, the temptation of sin still comes.

If you're already involved in sexual immorality it isn't too late to repent, turn from the sin, and turn to God. Extramarital sex has lessened the value of your spirit. However, God forgives and helps us begin that new relationship that is pleasing unto Him. Surrender to God by consecrating your body unto Him first and be excited about your True Love!
