If we can just praise God before we see it happen, or as my favorite song says, "In the Middle of It" which shows that we're walking by faith! What we've learned has to be exemplified at all times. The world wants to see a thing before they can believe it, but Christians must believe before they see it; that's walking by faith (2Corth.5:7)! begin to praise God. You've prayed, now it's time to praise! We're not praising because we're in the circumstances, but we're praising God for who we have with us in our circumstances. He's our truth in the matter, He's our strength to stand, He's our protection, while we're in it. We're also praising God that this won't last; that this trial will build our character. If you have been a praiser, it's not hard for you to do so; the Spirit of God unctons us to. But if you're not a praiser, it's something you haven't learned in your relationship with the Master who is supposed to be in control of your life.

It's not if you will come through, it's how long because praise will bring a peace that keeps you balance, not up and down. Praise Him till you find that peace to know that all is well! God begins to fight for you through your praise, through your spoken word, through your prayers. Ask Him for help!

God is truly worthy of praise! When we go to *Psalm 34* and say "I will bless the Lord at all times and His praise shall continually be in my mouth", you're getting His attention. That's what the angels do all day long. Do you think you only get His attention in prayer? No prayer and praise go together. "Continuously" means that your thoughts and energy are always on the Lord, not on the problem. The good that you say about Him; the happiness you display for the life He's given you no matter what; the actions to love Him and others at all times shows at all times. You were

born to praise Him! You're on display to praise Him.

**Luke 19:37** When he came near the place where the road goes down the Mount of Olives, the whole crowd of disciples began joyfully to praise God in loud voices for all the miracles they had seen:

**38** "Blessed is the king who comes in the name of the Lord!" "Peace in heaven and glory in the highest!"

**39** Some of the Pharisees in the crowd said to Jesus, "Teacher, rebuke your disciples!"

**40** "I tell you," he replied, "if they keep quiet, the stones will cry out." (NIV)

God has stones that will praise if we can't praise; God has earthquakes that will cry out with a tremendous shaking; God has trees that will fall in a forest and cry out, and yes you will hear it fall for Him; God has oceans that will rise with a fury and cry out for Him! But God loves to hear our shout with a voice of triumph;

our clap of praise that shakes and bring down the walls of the enemy. He loves to hear our sacrifice of praise when we're tired and think we can't go on, and

the Holy Spirit rises up in us to bring a praise that gets His attention! He loves to see our hands lifted in praise and our lips giving praise saying, "O Lord our Lord, how excellent is thy name in all the earth"— "O give thanks unto the Lord; for he is good: for his mercy endureth for ever." There is a release of whatever we need and even what we desire when we exalt, magnify, lift-up, and extol His name! You can't keep it within yourself, it

has to come out!

You know you praise your children when they do good but, how about praising them because you see God's potential in them, and you begin to speak it out by faith, even though you don't see it yet, as God has spoken over us for 2,000 years! You don't see it yet, but you are a peculiar people, wonderfully made, an heir to the kingdom, an over-comer! The things God sees in us, we are to see more in Him because He is the Designer and Architect of an intricate display of all. You can't know who you are unless you read the manual. You can't know who God is unless you read the manual (The Bible). There are no excuses (when you say, I don't know how)!

When you can't praise, you're being disobedient to the Lord. The King shall be praised and He shall be praised by His children! If the King is happy the children are blessed. Keep in mind that there is joy in praise; there's an uplift in our countenance; there's restoration in our body, soul, and spirit; there's a faith that rises saying, "I can do all things through Christ which

strengtheneth me!"; and there's a declaration that speaks truth about the God you love!

My heart aches when I don't praise Him and I know His heart probably does the same when He don't hear our praise. God Bless!

## Health Awareness Wellness For Life From The Kelsey Korner by Sis. Esther Corners

### INFLUENZA

Influenza, or the "flu," is an illness of the breathing system (known as respiratory system) and muscles caused by a virus. The flu attack the lungs. Problems from the flu can be deadly. Young children, people age 50 or older, and people with health problems are most likely to have the worst flu effects.

There are several types of flu virus. They can change from year to year. Your body's immune system may not be prepared for those changes, that's why you need a flu shot each year.

Each year scientist makes a flu vaccine to fight the viruses that are more likely to infect people that year. A flu shot may help protect the people near you, or reduce the

chances of spreading flu to others. The flu season is likely to attack more in October, lasting as late as May. The best time to get your shot is October through November. If you get the flu shot later it may still help to protect you.

#### HOW YOU CAN CATCH THE FLU:

The flu spreads in tiny fluid drops. Typically, influenza is transmitted through the air by coughs or sneezes, It can also be transmitted by direct contact from contaminated surfaces through hand-to-eye, hand-to-nose, or hand-to-mouth transmission. Once you have the virus, you can spread it for about a week. The best way to prevent the flu is to get a flu shot each year.

#### SYMPTOMS OF FLU:

Usually the first symptoms are chills or a chilly sensation, but fever is also common early in the infection, with body temperatures (100 to 102 degrees Fahrenheit lasting 3-4 days).

- Body aches and pains.
- Feeling tired and weak.
- Chest discomfort and cough.

- No appetite.

#### TIPS TO PROTECT YOURSELF AND OTHERS:

- Get a flu shot.
- Stay home when you're sick.
- Keep your hands clean; wash often with soap and water, use hand wipes or hand sanitizer.
- Cover your mouth and nose with a tissue when you cough or sneeze.

#### TREATMENT OF THE FLU:

- There are some drugs called "antiviral" that may help you to have a shorter, milder case of the flu, but they don't replace the flu shot.
- See your doctor within two days of having flu symptoms. Treatment can help you to feel better sooner or reduce the duration of the illness.
- Remember to rest and drink lots of fluids.

You don't get the flu from a flu shot!


