HELPING ME LOVE MY FELLOWMAN/WOMAN (Part2)

God wants me to get this lesson down pat. He has brought **Part 2** into the picture.

You cannot control anyone's actions except your own. Now the question is, do you choose to have it your way, or is not God your Father, or are you really choosing another master? You see the decision is not on others but the decision is really on us who want to follow Christ. Him shaping and molding the lumps, and us struggling to take control of his Hand to be what we want, continues to foul things up. Afterwhile you'll be saying there's no

hope for me! Paul says in Romans 7:19-20, *For the good that I would I do not; but the evil which I would not that I do. Now if I do that I would not, it is no more I that do it but sin that dwelleth in me.*

Romans 6:12, Let not sin therefore reign In your mortal body, that ye should obey it in the lusts thereof.

[Lusts could mean any desire : You don't

want to be wrong, and needing to be right ; You wanting badly for that situation to just go away cause you're not giving up]. Now that's strong desire, jut plain stubborn!

I Surrender

Well we're in a struggle of who is master, us or the Lord.

Romans 6:14, for sin shall not have dominion over you: for ye are not under the law,

The decision is not on others, but the decision is really on us... *but under grace.* The law revealed sin. Since under grace, we're not to continue in sin. Sin is still revealed to those in

Christ, by the power of the Holy Spirit, who is our Helper and who gives us the power to obey the lordship of Jesus Christ.

One thing to realize is the curse of the law has been completely lifted off of

Righteousness God in Him.

(For He hath made Him to be sin for us, who knew no sin that we might be made the righteousness of God in Him, 2Corinthians 5:21.)

We must resist the emotions striving in us. What is our strongest force against the enemy? Love! L O V E !

What is the enemy trying to stop us from doing ? (Loving our fellowman / woman)!

Well since we know **the key**, are we going to use the key against the enemy,

against God in rebellion, or for God in trusting Him and Him alone.

After praying and confessing your sin to God, getting into God's Word is the next step. If we've lost site of whose children we are, then let me Refresh you.

- *John 15:16 I have been chosen and appointed to bear fruit*
- *2Corinthians 5:17 I am a minister of reconciliation for God.*
- *Philippians 4:13 I can do all things through Christ, who strengthens me.*
- *1Peter 5:8 I am an enemy of the devil.*
- *Luke 7:47; Ephesians 4:32 I am forgiven.*
- *Matthew 5:44 I can love my enemies.*
- *1John4:18; 2Timothy 1:7 I have not fear, but power, love, and a sound mind.*
- *1John 4:21; John 15:12 I am commanded that if I love God, I am to love my brother.*

(Galatians 2:20).—(Inside me to help me in times of trouble).

I don't have to act like my old self. I don't have to act like I have no power over the situation because I do. God has equipped me to be *rooted deep in love and founded securely on love. Ephesians 3:17*

- **I have the power to pray** (Lord take these thoughts from me. I cast down these vain imaginations and I bring them into captivity to the obedience of Christ. My thoughts are now subject to Christ! Jesus),
