It was a Friday night and I had gone to a revival at church. I got back home about 10:00 and checked to see if my husband was ok. He was sleep, so I went to bed. About 1:00 am he woke me up. He was dying. I called 911. I couldn't ride in the ambulance with him because the EMT's were working on him. I arrived at the hospital and was led to a small room and told to wait. When the doctors came in, I knew my husband had gone on to glory. It seemed as though the world as I knew it, of a marriage of 10 years just stood still, even though someone is sick, death is still a stranger. I asked to see my husband. I went into the room and the look on his face was as if he had never been sick. I knew then, what the scripture meant when it said, "**absent from the body but present with the Lord.**" This scripture gave me peace, because I knew there was no more pain. **Ps. 94:19 says, "In the multitude of my thoughts within me Thy comforts delight my soul."**

After the funeral, it hit me, "I don't have a job!" I was 51 years old with a 12 year old son that needed to be taken care of. Needless to say, I begin to worry; this made the devil really happy. I thank God for godly friends and a God fearing pastor. I called my Pastor and he prayed for me and encouraged me with these words: "**Be careful for nothing but in everything by prayer and supplication with thanksgiving let your requests be made known to God, and the peace of God which passeth all understanding, shall keep your hearts and minds through Christ Jesus Phil. 4:6-7.**" He reminded me of scriptures that I knew would give me comfort and peace. I started repeating the scripture out loud, so my Spirit could be fed.

I called Lee College and made an appointment to take the enrollment test. I finished High School in 1963 so I knew nobody but Jesus Christ my Savior could help me. I failed the English and Math test, so I enrolled in remedial classes to help with Math and English. Well, when I took the test again, I passed with flying colors, **HALLELUAH. Ps.91:15 say, "Call on me and I will answer."** I enrolled in the Business Administration Class. I went one semester and decided I would go to an employment office and check out my skills. I made a good score on my test so I was offered a part time job. I took the job and continued to go to school at night. After 3 months I was offered a full time job making enough money to take care of me and my child so I finished my semester and didn't go back.

My story is, no matter what difficulties comes your way, "**my God is able to do exceedingly, abundantly, above all we ask or think, according to the power that worked within 'US'.**" Read the Word and hide them in your heart because trouble will come, disappointment will come. God is the same yesterday today and forever. What He did for me, He will do for you. Just keep the faith and never doubt. Trust God, trust His Word, and He won't fail. Be encouraged with these words from **Romans 8:38-39, "For I am persuaded, that neither death, nor life, nor angels, nor principalities, nor powers, nor things present, nor things to come, Nor height, nor depth, nor any other creature, shall be able to separate us from the love of God, which is in Christ Jesus, our Lord."**

YOU MAKE A DIFFERENCE

This second month of the year I know you are continuing to change something in your life. Nothing stays the same. Therefore, you're either moving, changing jobs, finding a new Love; or your life is going through a sickness, a death, a financial hurt; or you're a soldier being released back home. Sometimes our plans don't go according to how we think they should.

You hadn't planned this change and now you're learning how to cope in this new direction. If not, how are you writing your story now? You're never write it alone

because there will be others involved, whether you want them to be or not. Remember, this is only one chapter in your life. If you wanted to change anything, what would it be? Joseph probably wanted to change everything in the first chapter of his life, but not the last chapter because when others thought it was for bad, God counted it for good. Joseph kept the right attitude to be used of God.

When we look at Paul's life, how he killed Christians in the first chapter of his life but the next chapter was changed when he became a Christian. He still went through many things after becoming a Christian. Things just don't stop happening to us, but ever so much better with Jesus in our lives. No matter what battle we go through, God is the best thing that can ever happen in our life. He brings about a peace that we can never describe while going through what seemed like a shock at first, but then while giving the situation to God, we eventually are overcome with a peace that surpasses all our understanding. God uses every circumstance we go through as a learning experience and to get closer to Him. It will be for the good of you as well as for others.

Don't you just hate it when you're trying to tell loved ones, not to go down the wrong road, because you've been that way and it's not the right path, and sometimes they don't want to listen? So many people say, I have to go through and experience it for myself—those you're trying to teach a lesson to really don't have to make those same mistakes and wind-up in some consequence. Why do they want to experience mistakes all the time? Is it because they have a problem with surrender? God is trying to teach us through others. Even in Joseph's life, there were some good times that even brought the brothers and the whole family back together; that brought his life to a full circle. As Joseph pursued through his circumstances and God was faithful, Joseph mattered in every aspect of his life. Your atmosphere changes because you never give up hope; you find joy in God; He fills you with peace, love and strength so that on the outside and the inside your confidence grows stronger which gives you courage beyond measure. And it's all because you have a Helper within. His power is greater to hold you up in times when you're not looking at the prize or when you're not looking to the next chapter. There will always be a next chapter because we always leave a legacy of life. Your life matters because **you make a difference for God's purpose!** His purpose for you matters!

HEALTHY DIET

RECOMMENDATIONS:

1. Know your fats in the diet, good and bad. Not all fats are bad. Fats provide calories which give you energy. Fat help the body absorb nutrients, such as Vitamin A, D, E, and K. Fats implant oils and fish and can help prevent chronic disease.
2. Make the most of your daily fat from fish, nuts, and vegetable oil, such as olive, peanut, and canola oil.
3. Avoid saturated fats, mainly in animal products, such as dark meat and skin.
4. Limit solid fats like butter—stick margarine, shortening, and lard.
5. Get no more than 25% to 35% of your total calories from fat.
6. Read food labels, eating too much fat can be unhealthy.

GRAINS:

1. Eat at least 3 ounces of whole grain bread, cereal, crackers, rice or pasta everyday.
2. Look for the word "*whole*" before the grain name on the ingredient.

Fruits and vegetables are a big part of a healthy diet. A diet full of fruits and vegetables help prevent Heart Disease and Cancer!

VWGETABLES:

Vegetables provide needed vitamins and minerals. They provide fiber and are low in fats and calories. Eat more dark green vegetables such as spinach and yellow corn.

FRUITS:

Fruits also are a good source of fiber. Eat a variety of fruits. Choose fresh frozen or canned. Eat whole fruit more often than juice.
