FLEXIBLE OR RIGID

While going through a transition, some attitude changes, and listening to God's plan instead of mine, I read somewhere, "don't bring your old thoughts to the process." There is a process going on when you don't know what to do.

The old thoughts were the things that had not happened yet for me. The old thoughts were "it's time to go, time to change, you can't change others, but you can change yourself!"

The process was hearing how God wanted to do it and me being still. Me being still is hard at times but when I fast and pray, I'm still. That means I'm really looking for **God's answer**, really wanting **His solution** and not by manipulation. I've always learned that what I want doesn't count, because I don't always get my way with God when it's not in my best interest. God always knows what's best!

Being God's servant means you have to be flexible to change, rather than rigid with God.

Rigid means old thoughts, old habits, old ways to solve a situation. God never changes, but His process may change with you, His answer may change with you, His way of transitioning you, **you** will have to adapt to! **Behold I will do a new thing; now it shall spring forth; shall ye not know it?...(Is.43:19)** God is saying **now** it shall spring forth, be in tune with 'Me', but we're so rigid in our flesh, that our spirit can't be sensitive to **His** new thing, His process of the thing and not taking hold of it or realizing it, because our former religious observance has bogged us down!

I am learning to change **within** to solve the problem **within**, rather than trying to get away from the problem at hand. We always have to look within instead of outward. I know myself, I am a 'Confronter' because I don't like problems. And if the problem lingers without a solution, it's at a standstill, and more ammunition for the enemy within and outwardly.

Change is inevitable and

I've heard T. D. Jakes say, change won't come until all the doubters die out. Well, in the Word of God, change didn't come for the Israelites, especially for Caleb and Joshua, until all those that were 20 and above, died in the Wilderness. I'm looking for my Promise to come before then, because God will leave an enemy to witness your Promise. That gives Him glory! Hallelujah! It Can Happen!

.I am the Lord: that is My Name: and My glory will I not give to another, ... Behold, the former things are come to pass, and new things do I declare: before they spring forth I tell you of them (Is.42:8-9). This is talking about prophecies, predictions, new things. Impression Without Expression Leads To Depression:

Be ye therefore followers of God, as dear children (Eph.5:1).

But be ye doers of the Word, and not hearers only, deceiving your own selves (Jam. 1:22).

Impression means imprint, stamp, mark.

Expression means convey, voice, expound.

Depression means hollow or low place, inadequacy, decrease in force of activity.

I read a story called : **"Mistaken Identity"** — Two cars waiting at a stoplight. The light turned green, but the man didn't notice it. A woman in the car behind him began pound-

ing on her steering wheel and yelling at the man to move. The man didn't move. The woman went ballistic and started ranting and raving at the man, blowing her car horn, screamed curses at the man. The light turned yellow. The man hearing the commotion, looks up, saw the yellow light and accelerated through the intersection just as the light turned red. The woman was be-

side herself, screaming in frustration as she missed her chance to get through the intersection.

Still ranting, she heard a tap on her widow, looked up into the barrel of a gun held by a very serious looking policeman. The policeman told her to shut off her car, while keeping both hands in sight. She obeyed and was speechless at what was happening. After she shut off the engine, the policeman ordered her to exit her car with her hands up, place her hands on the roof of her car, and was quickly handcuffed, and put into the patrol car.

She was too bewildered by the chain of events to ask any questions and was driven to the police station where she was fingerprinted, photographed, searched, booked, and placed in a cell.

After a couple of hours, a policeman approached the cell, opened the door for her, and escorted her back to the booking desk where the original officer was waiting with her personal effects.

He handed her bag containing her things and said, "I'm really sorry for this mistake. But you see, I pulled up behind your car while you were blowing your horn, flip-

ping that guy off and cursing a blue streak at the car in front of you, and then I noticed the 'Choose Life' license plate holder, the 'What Would Jesus Do', and 'Follow Me to Sunday School' bumper stickers, and the chrome plated Christian fish emblem on the trunk, so naturally I assumed that you had stolen someone else' car.

I will always think of this story when sitting at the light. This one example really catches your eye of an outward Expression having no stamped Impression that would lead others to Christ.

There **is** an **impression** that looks like a strong influence. The mark is there, the imprint's there, the stamp of Jesus is on your life, **but** there's no **Expression**, no voice, no out-put, no expounding, no giving out, no conveying to others, no characteristics of Jesus, and it leads one to the thought of **Depression**, waste, feelings of inadequacy, slackness, being hollow, and stagnate for those that say they are servants and for those that need the servant's actions.

Studying without service, without being a doer of the Word, leads to stagnation. There is no continuous flow, no joy, no tremendous fruit

bearing in that Christian's walk with The Master

We are first converts (*turning from sin to God*), then disciples (*learners, apprentices, and followers*) of Christ.

Discipleship is commitment to learn and applying truths to everyday life, becoming like Christ, sharing Christianity with others, serving the church, and fulfilling the goals God has personally designed for each person. The Word says, *For if any be a hearer of the word and not a doer, he is like unto a man beholding his natural face in a glass:*

He sees only that which is external and therefore cannot make a proper evaluation internally.

For he beholds himself, and goes his way, and straightway forgets what manner of man he was.

An evaluation of ourselves is necessary.

But whoso looks into the perfect law of liberty, and continues therein, he being not a forgetful hearer, but a doer of the work, this man shall be blessed in his deed" (Jam.1:23-25).

Obedying the word of God brings great blessings. However, the only way it can be obeyed is for the Believer to unequivocally place their faith in Christ and the Cross.

As we look in the bible, The Sea of Galilee is full of life because it takes in water and also gives it out. However, in The Dead Sea, nothing lives because there

is no out-flow, and water becomes stagnate (standing still).

Another example: Let's look at eating. In our everyday life, the food goes in but if not eliminated can cause sickness, and a complete shutdown. No exercise, no muscles toned, heartbeat becomes sluggish (*not beating with the rhythm of life*) and will lead to fat buildup. The **body** muscles have got to be toned, molded and shaped.

The **soul** has to be transformed by the renewing of the mind having soulish things taken off and putting God's

truths into practice. Last the **spirit** has to bring forth fruit.

When putting a seed in the ground, you're expecting it to grow and bear fruit, not just for you, but for someone else. The Word of God says, *Verily, verily, I say unto you, Except a corn of wheat fall into the ground and die, it abideth alone: but if it die, it brings forth much fruit. If any man serve Me, let him follow Me; and where I am, there shall also My servant be: if any man serve me, him will my Father honour*" (John. 12:24,26).

Well, if you get happy (*composed, tranquil*) where you are, you'll never get to where you

need to be. Remember we've been **impressed** (*stamped, marked*) to **Express** (*voice, expound*). Not to just look like we're His, from the outside, but to imitate (*copy*) God (*follow his example*), being a doer because of His inside witness to obey.

My constant flow of God comes by telling someone else about Him, not keeping Him to myself.

Everything is shaped according to His Will. There is no time to get depressed or stagnate when the flow is constant, for the body muscles are being toned, molded and shaped; the mind/soul is being trans-

formed and renewed with joy; and wow the fruit of the spirit is coming forth.

Without Expression of God's Word to someone, He doesn't receive glory. There are too many blessings not to express. Be a bearer of Good News about Jesus!

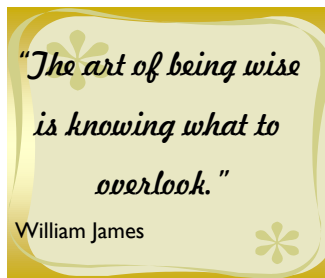
